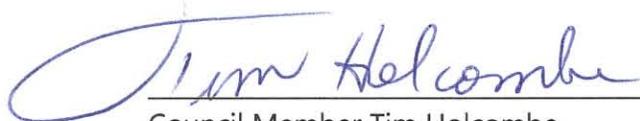

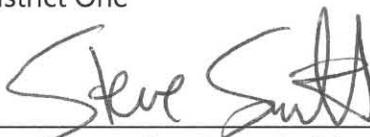

District One



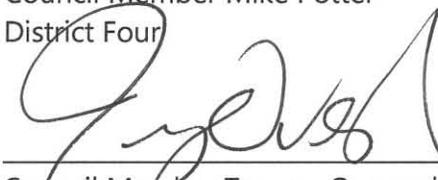
Council Member Steve Smith

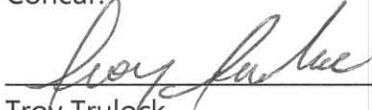

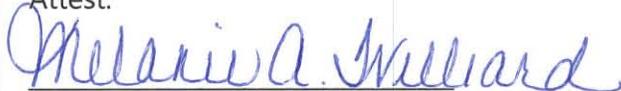

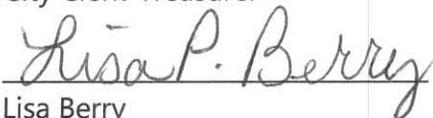
