**RECIPE:** Foolproof Peanut Butter Fudge

1 (16.3-oz.) container creamy peanut butter (about 1-3/4 cups)  
1 (1-lb.) container vanilla frosting (or flavor of choice)

### CHECK IT OUT:

If you are looking for a safe holiday outing, then you definitely want to check out Madison Station's Polar Express Christmas on Main tree display. The Senior Center's tree is right next to Main Street Café. Decorated in gold, we send love and holiday wishes to all our seniors.

Line a 9" x 9" pan with foil and set aside. Place peanut butter and frosting into a medium-sized microwave-safe bowl. Do not stir. Microwave on high for 1 minute, and then stir until combined and completely smooth. Pour mixture into prepared pan and spread evenly. Place in refrigerator until firm. Remove fudge from pan using the foil, and then cut into squares. This will be a bit softer than traditional fudge, but it is yummy.
