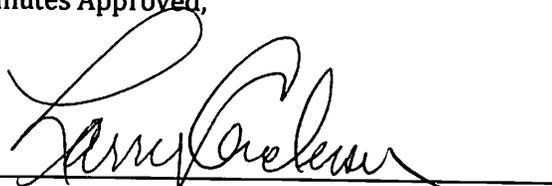
OTHER BUSINESS

3. Jeanne Steadman brought to the attention of members an article in the *Madison Weekly* regarding the Design Review Guidelines.

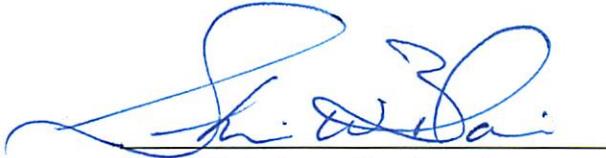
With no additional business to discuss, Chairman Anderson adjourned the meeting at 6:20 p.m.
