DEBBIE OVERCASH, MADISON STREET FESTIVAL CHAIR, UPDATE ON THE STREET FESTIVAL

The 2013 Street Festival Committee awarded Madison education based grants totaling \$6,700.00 including two scholarships worth \$1,000.00 each that will go to a senior at Bob Jones and James Clemens High School.

Mrs. Overcash also introduced Sharon Holcombe who will be the chairman of the Street Festival next year.


