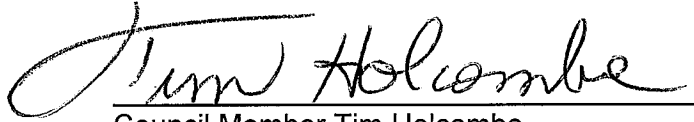

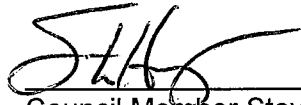

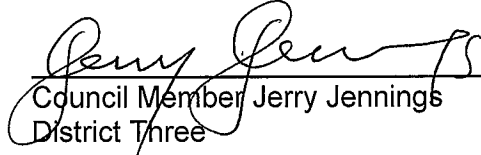

District Two



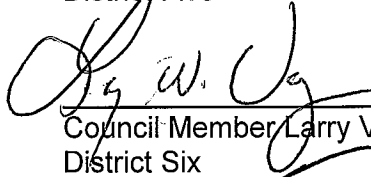
