SWIMMING POOL SAFETY BARRIER REQUIREMENTS AFFIDAVIT

The intent of the swimming pool barrier requirements is to prevent uncontrolled access by children from a street or adjacent properties and from the home. Barriers shall be in compliance with sections 305 of the 2015 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code.

I, (we), the undersigned, understand the following requirements for building a pool and pool safety barrier. I, (we), further understand that this protection must be in place prior to the pool being filled with water.

A minimum 4 foot tall fence that will not allow passage of a 4 inch sphere. If a chain link fence or fences with horizontal or diagonal members are used, then additional requirements apply in accordance with Section 305 of the 2018 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code.**

Gates shall swing out and be self-closing and have a self-latching device that meets Section 305 of the 2018 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code.**

If the house is used as a barrier then the doors and windows that lead to the pool shall have alarms or other approved systems installed in accordance with Section 305 of the 2018 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code.**

Suction Entrapment avoidance for pools and spas shall be provided in accordance with APSP 7.

If existing fences are used on neighbor's property, these fences will have to be retrofitted to meet this code. In addition, a written and signed agreement will have to be submitted by each neighboring property owner that shares a fence.

Final Inspection is required before the pool can be used.

This agreement to comply is necessary for a construction permit to be issued to the contractor

NOTE: Existing fences may or may not meet pool safety barrier requirements. Shadowbox fences typically do not constitute an approved pool safety barrier and will have to meet the minimum safety requirements.

I, (we), understand that not having a complete barrier around the perimeter of the pool is a violation of Section 305, 2018 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code.
